- A. You will need a notebook/laptop computer or other wireless device with an IEEE 802.11b/g network card.
- B. Library staff is not able to provide technical assistance due to the variety of hardware available

- C. Printing is not available on the wireless network.

EASY ACCESS INSTRUCTIONS:

- Be sure your wireless device is activated.
- Open your wireless networks utility usually found in the lower right hand corner of your screen.
- Click "View Wireless Networks."
- Choose the Bridgeport c Library Network and connect to it.
- Close the utility and open your browser.
- Type in your library card number and check the box to accept the Library's Internet Access Policy.
- Now you can access the Internet - get your email, surf the net, finish your research!
